## **Program Overview:**

The Betty Ann Darby Scholarship Program awards graduating seniors who will be pursuing advanced academic or professional degrees in an arts discipline or in arts education. The Arts Alliance will award three scholarships. Two \$1000 scholarships and one \$500 scholarship will be awarded. To be considered, seniors' primary resident must be in Florence County or be graduating from a Florence County public or private high school. Applications are open to home-school and private school students.

The Betty Ann Darby Scholarships are merit scholarships awarded predominantly on the basis of demonstrated talent, passion for the arts and intention to pursue a major in an arts discipline (visual, literary, or performing arts) or in arts education. All application and support materials are due to the Florence Regional Arts Alliance on or before Tuesday, **March 12, 2019**. This is a postmarked deadline or electronic submission deadline, meaning that applications must be postmarked or electronically submitted no later than the stated date of Tuesday, March 12, 2019. INCOMPLETE or late application or support materials will not be accepted. ### Essay

In no more than two (2) typed pages, please respond to the following:

*Why have you chosen to study the specific arts area(s) you have chosen? Be specific regarding your chosen arts discipline and intended major. Indicate when and how you became involved in the arts as well as why you have continued to be involved. Specify your goals for pursuing an academic or professional degree in your intended major(s). Also address your ultimate career goals and how your studies relate to those goals.*

**Official Transcript:**

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that an official transcript is submitted and included with the application packet.

**Recommendation Letters:**

Three recommendation letters should be included in the application packet. The letters of recommendation can be from anyone that has been involved with the applicant's academic or community activities. Letters from family members will not be accepted.

Those writing recommendation letters are encouraged to consider the applicant's dependability, motivation, tendency to exceed expectations, attitude toward learning, character, passion for the arts, and talent.

**Support Materials:**

Please include a representative sampling of your work in your primary arts discipline. Although an applicant's sampling does not need to be professionally produced, the Awarding Committee regards quality of recording or production as important as the quality of performance.

Visual art samples should include a maximum of three (3) images. Audio/video samples should include three (3) samples not to exceed a total maximum of eight (8) minutes. Literary samples should include 3 samples not to exceed a total maximum of six (6) pages in twelve-(12) point type.

**All applicants are strongly encouraged to give serious thought with respect to the best means for effectively showcasing their talent. For example, still photographs of a student seeking to pursue drama would not be as effective as a monologue or other video scene.**

**Support materials are considered an integral part of the total application package and will be retained for documentation purposes.**

**Note:** Do not bind application materials in any way other than with binder clips or paper clips. The applicant's name should appear on all pages and each support material piece.
